Consultant Program Reports from February 23, 2021 to May 4, 2021

The Executive Officer took the following actions related to vocational nursing and psychiatric technician programs (Programs).

Effective February 23, 2021:

 Concord Career College, San Diego, Vocational Nursing Program – Request Approved.

The Program requested the Board grant continued full approval for a four-year period beginning February 1, 2021 and issue a certificate accordingly.

• Northern California Nursing Academy, Vocational Nursing Program – Request Approved.

The Program requested the Board grant initial approval of the vocational nursing program for the four-year period beginning February 23, 2021 and issue a certificate accordingly.

Additionally, the Program requested approval to begin their program with an initial full-time class of 18 students on April 5, 2021. The projected graduation date is May 29, 2022.

Additionally, the Program requested approval of their 54-week curriculum consists of 682 theory hours and 954 clinical hours totaling 1636 program hours.

• Summit Career College, El Cajon, Vocational Nursing Program – Request Approved.

The Program requested approval to admit a full-time day class of 30 students to commence on March 22, 2021, with a graduation date of March 18, 2022. This class will replace the class which is scheduled to graduate on March 12, 2021.

Effective March 24, 2021:

Advanced College, South Gate, Vocational Nursing Program – Request Approved.

The Program requested the Board grant continued full approval for a four-year period beginning February 20, 2021 and issue a certificate accordingly.

• Career Care Institute, Moreno Valley, Vocational Nursing Program – Request Approved.

The Program requested approval to begin a full-time day class of 30 students commencing on April 5, 2021, graduating on August 21, 2022 to replace the class that graduated on January 17, 2021.

Concorde Career College, San Bernardino, Vocational Nursing Program – Request Approved.

The Program requested the Board grant continued full approval for a four-year period beginning February 1, 2021 and issue a certificate accordingly.

• Southeast California College, Vocational Nursing Program – Request Approved.

The Program requested approval of their curriculum revision to include 1555 total program hours, including 599 theory hours and 956 clinical hours.

• State Center Community College District, Madera Center, Vocational Nursing Program – Request Approved.

The Program requested approval to increase frequency of admission from one class of 30 students every three semesters to admission of one class of 30 students per year (August, fall semester).

Effective April 6, 2021:

• Bakersfield Adult School, Vocational Nursing Program – Request Approved.

The Program requested the Board grant continued full approval for the Program for a four-year period beginning May 15, 2021 and issue a certificate accordingly.

• Carrington College, Sacramento, Vocational Nursing Program – Requests Approved.

The Program requested approval of a full-time class of 30 students to commence on April 12, 2021 with an expected graduation date of March 25, 2022 to replace the class that graduates April 9, 2021.

Additionally, the Program requested placement on the April 19, 2021 Education and Practice Committee Meeting agenda for review of the previous recommendation for Provisional Approval.

Carrington College, San Jose, Vocational Nursing Program – Request Approved.

The Program requested approval to admit a full-time class of 30 students commencing on April 26, 2021, graduating on April 6, 2022 to replace the class that graduates on April 24, 2021.

• Moriah Medical College, Vocational Nursing Program – Requests Approved.

The Program requested the Board grant initial approval of the vocational nursing program for a four-year period beginning April 6, 2021 and issue a certificate accordingly.

Additionally, the Program requested to begin their program with an initial full-time class of 30 students on April 19, 2021, only, and graduating July 3, 2022.

Additionally, the Program requested approval of their 60-week curriculum, four 15-week terms of 1554 hours, including 600 theory hours and 954 clinical hours.

• Quest Nursing Education Center, Vocational Nursing Program – Requests Approved.

The Program requested to admit a part-time day class of 30 students to commence on May 17, 2021 with a projected graduation date of August 12, 2022 to replace the class that graduated on May 14, 2021.

Additionally, the Program requested to admit a part-time evening class of 30 students to commence on May 17, 2021 with a projected graduation date of August 12, 2022 to replace the class that graduated on February 17, 2021.

• Summit College, San Bernardino (previously in Colton), Vocational Nursing Program – Request Approved.

The Program requested approval to add three students to the PT 4-26-2021 Class. Current class is 30 students and the three students will be above original number of students in cohort.

• Unitek College, Bakersfield, Vocational Nursing Program – Requests Approved.

The Program requested to admit a class of 36 full-time day students to start on May 10, 2021 with an expected graduation date of April 29, 2022.

Additionally, the Program requested request to admit a class of 36 part-time evening students to start on June 29, 2021 with an expected graduation date of January 14, 2023.

• Unitek College, Fremont, Vocational Nursing Program – Requests Approved.

The Program requested to admit a class of 36 students to a full-time day class to start on June 1, 2021 and graduate on May 6, 2022.

Also, the Program requested to admit a class of 36 students to a full-time day class to start on July 12, 2021 and graduate on June 24, 2022.

Additionally, the Program requested an ongoing pattern of admissions to include:

- o Seven 46-week full time day classes of 36 students per year,
- One 62-week full-time evening class per year, and
- Two 75-week part-time evening/weekend classes of 36 students to replace graduating students only.

Effective April 20, 2021:

• California Career Institute, Vocational Nursing Program – Request Approved.

The Program requested to admit a part-time evening class of 30 students commencing on May 10, 2021, with the projected graduation date of January 15, 2023 to replace the class that graduated on March 7, 2021.

• Citrus College, Vocational Nursing Program – Request Approved.

The Program requested the Board grant continued full approval for a four-year period beginning May 12, 2021 and issue a certificate accordingly.

• Long Beach City College, Vocational Nursing Program – Request Approved.

The Program requested the Board grant continued full approval for a four-year period beginning May 11, 2021 and issue a certificate accordingly.

• Summit College, San Bernardino, Vocational Nursing Program – Requests Approved.

The Program requested to admit a full-time day class of 30 students to commence on April 23, 2021, with a graduation date of April 22, 2022. This class will replace the class which graduated on February 5, 2021.

Also, the Program requested to admit a part-time evening class of 30 students to commence on April 23, 2021, with a graduation date of November 20, 2022. This class will replace the class which is scheduled to graduate on April 11, 2021.

Effective May 4, 2021:

• Beaumont Adult School, Vocational Nursing Program – Request Approved.

The Program requested the Board grant continued full approval for a four-year period beginning May 11, 2021 and issue a certificate accordingly.

• Glendale Career College, Vocational Nursing Program – Request Approved.

The Program requested approval of a curriculum change from a full-time curriculum of 60 weeks to a revised full-time curriculum of 60 weeks, effective May 4, 2021. The proposed curriculum consists of 698 theory hours and 954 clinical hours totaling 1652 hours.

North-West College, Long Beach, Vocational Nursing Program – Request Approved.

The Program requested approval of a curriculum change from a full-time curriculum of 60 weeks to a revised full-time curriculum of 60 weeks, effective May 4, 2021. The proposed curriculum consists of 698 theory hours and 954 clinical hours totaling 1652 hours.
