



NOTICE OF PROPOSED EMERGENCY REGULATIONS

To All Interested Parties:

Government Code section 11346.1, as amended by AB 302, Chapter 73, Statutes of 2006, requires that an adopting agency provide a notice of the proposed emergency action to every person who has filed a request for notice of regulatory action with the agency. The notice shall be provided to those persons at least five working days before submitting an emergency regulation to the Office of Administrative Law.

Attached are the proposed emergency regulations by the Bureau of Vocational Nursing and Psychiatric Technicians (BVNPT) relating to the unfingerprinted licensee population, the mandatory fee change that is required to ensure that sufficient funds are available to implement this consumer protection requirement, and the BVNPT's Finding of Emergency.

The BVNPT plans to have a hearing on these regulations in the very near future and will send out notices as soon as the date of the hearing is determined.
