SUBJECT	Decision Making Processes for Education Programs

The purpose of this memo is to provide the Board with information on the existing process to review and approve or deny school requests. Attached, please find a report outlining the decisions from the EO's review from April 1-June 30, 2020, and a flow chart illustrating the overall program approval process.

The Board delegated responsibility for specified, routine and non-controversial decisions to the Executive Officer in the mid to late 1990s; so long ago that staff is not able to verify the exact date and Board action. This matter was discussed briefly at the Education and Practice Committee meeting but was not forwarded with a recommendation for action.

The original delegation was established to improve the efficiency of the Board's Education committee and the Board itself. It also enables the schools to respond more quickly; that is, upon notification of a decision from the EO, they may start the process of admitting students or implementing updates in curriculum, and not wait until the Committee or the Board is able to meet and approve the reports. This saves between one to three months.

The current practice, which predates the current management, as outlined on the attached flowchart.

- 1. The NECs provide their reports to the SNEC for review
- 2. Upon SNEC approval, the NECs and SNEC meet with the EO and Counsel, approximately twice a month.
- The EO approves or denies the NEC recommendations, and Counsel reviews for legal compliance.
- 4. The NECs notify their assigned programs of these decisions or of a referral to the Committee and/or Board.
- 5. When indicated, the reports are forwarded to the Committee for review and recommendation to the full Board.

One recommended addition would be the production and dissemination of a regular report, either monthly or quarterly, to the full Board to memorialize these decisions.

Without this delegation, the Board members will review and vote on these requests. This would take one of the following forms:

- 1. If the Board elects to do so on a quarterly basis, or to delegate the sole authority to the Education and Practice Committee at a meeting, there would be approximately 25-35 additional reports to review.
- 2. If the Board elects to approve the reports on a monthly basis, or to delegate the sole authority to the Education and Practice Committee, there would be a "mailout" system set up, likely mirroring the process used for the disciplinary balloting. This would likely entail 10-15 reports each month, or five to seven semi-monthly packets. Assuming the full Board, this would require at least six members voting. If delegated only to the Committee, it would entail three of the four members.

Either of these structures creates new staff work to upload the reports, tabulate the votes and communicate with the NECs and programs. This may not be easily absorbable in the current structure.

Staff recommends that the Board approve the current delegation of decisions to the Executive Officer. This includes:

- Review reports with no deficiencies or minor program deficiencies
- Initial program approval
- Continued program approval
- Request to admit a class
- Request to admit students
- Changes to curriculum
- Change in program hours

Executive Officer Review of Nursing Education Consultant (NEC) Program Reports Second Quarter 2020

The Executive Officer took the following actions related to vocational nursing and psychiatric technician programs (Programs).

Effective April 14, 2020:

California Career Institute Vocational Nursing Program – Requests Denied.

The Program requested to admit a part-time class of 30 students, at the Garden Grove campus, commencing on May 4, 2020, and graduating on January 16, 2022, to replace September 29, 2019, graduating class.

In addition, the Program requested to admit a part-time class of 30 students, at the Hawthorne campus, commencing on June 2, 2020, and graduating March 6, 2022, to replace February 9, 2020, graduating class.

Copper Mountain College Vocational Nursing Program – Request Approved.
