Re: Action Requested from Board Members Post Pandemic

The Nursing Education Consultants (NECs) presented the following recommendations for post COVID-19 teaching modalities during the April 2021 Education Committee Meeting and during the May 2021 Board meeting. Public comment was also held.

Staff recommends the Education and Practice Committee present these for approval by the full Board at the August 20, 2021 meeting:

- 1. BVNPT will continue to approve live clinical simulation for clinical hours in the skills lab on an individual program basis.
- 2. BVNPT will allow consideration and approval of 100% online theory for current theory hours (synchronous class-100% live lecture online) with no change to curriculum, only the teaching modality. Program requests will be reviewed on an individual basis.
- 3. BVNPT will allow consideration and approval of hybrid theory curriculum requests from programs, teaching modalities other than face to face classroom theory hours. Program requests will be reviewed on an individual basis.
- BVNPT will allow consideration and approval of virtual clinical simulation in place of live skills lab hours and/or to enhance concepts within theory. Program requests will be reviewed on an individual basis.

Once the state of emergency is completely lifted and pending board approval, these will become our best practices.
