Subject: Executive Officer Review Decisions Report of Board Nursing

Education Consultant Program Reports from November 2, 2021 to

December 30, 2021.

The Executive Officer took the following actions related to vocational nursing and psychiatric technician programs (Programs).

Effective November 2, 2021:

Angeles Institute, Vocational Nursing Program – Request Approved.

The Program requested to admit a full-time class of 40 students commencing on January 3, 2022, with a graduation date of November 4, 2022, to replace a class that graduates on November 19, 2021.

 Carrington College, Sacramento, Vocational Nursing Program – Request Approved.

The Program requested to admit a full-time class of 30 students to commence on November 29, 2021, with a graduation date of November 11, 2022, to replace the class graduating on November 26, 2021.

 College of Nursing and Technology, Vocational Nursing Program – Request Approved.

The Program requested the Board grant continued full approval for a four-year period beginning September 14, 2021 and issue a certificate accordingly.

• Glendale Career College, Vocational Nursing Program – Request Not Approved. Refer to the Glendale Career College EO Decision on November 16, 2021.

The Program requested the Board grant continued full approval for a four-year period beginning November 14, 2021 and issue a certificate accordingly. The NEC will bring the request back for review if and when violations are corrected.

LAUSD – Maxine Waters Employment Preparation Center, Vocational Nursing Program – Request Approved.

The Program requested the Board grant approval of their revised full-time 54-week curriculum, effective November 8, 2021. The proposed curriculum consists of 604 theory hours and 956 clinical hours, totaling 1560 hours.

North West College Anaheim, Vocational Nursing Program – Requests Approved.

The Program requested to admit a full-time evening class of 30 students to commence on December 1, 2021, with a graduation date of February 23, 2022 to replace the class that graduated on October 18, 2021.

Additionally, the Program requested the Board grant approval of a curriculum change from a full-time curriculum of 60 weeks to a revised full-time curriculum of 60 weeks, effective November 2, 2021. The proposed curriculum consists of 698 theory hours and 954 clinical hours totaling 1652 hours.

North West College Riverside, Vocational Nursing Program – Request Approved.

The Program requested to admit a full-time class of 30 students to commence on November 8, 2021, with a graduation date of February 24, 2023 to replace the class graduating on October 20, 2021.

Pacific Times Healthcare College, Vocational Nursing Program – Requests Approved.

The Program requested the Board grant initial approval for the four-year period beginning November 2, 2021 and issue a certificate accordingly.

Additionally, the Program requested to begin a vocational nursing program with an initial full-time class of 26 students on January 24, 2022, only, and graduating April 29, 2023.

Additionally, the Program requested the Board grant approval of the program's 56-week full-time curriculum, which includes one 13-week, one 15-week, and two 14-week terms, of 1567 hours, including 609 theory hours and 958 clinical hours.

• Summit College El Cajon, Vocational Nursing Program – Request Approved.

The Program requested to admit a full-time day class of 20 students to commence on November 15, 2021, with an expected graduation date of November 11, 2022. This class is an additional class.

• Summit College San Bernardino, Vocational Nursing Program – Requests Approved.

The Program requested to admit a full-time day class of 20 students to commence on November 15, 2021, with an expected graduation date of November 11, 2022. This class will replace the class which will graduate on November 5, 2021.

Additionally, the Program requested to admit a part time evening class of 20 students to commence on November 15, 2021, with an expected graduation date of June 25, 2023. This class will replace the class graduated on September 5, 2021.

Effective November 16, 2021:

 Allied Medical and Health Services, Vocational Nursing Program – Request Approved.

The Program requested to admit a part-time class of 9 students to commence on January 22, 2022, with a graduation date of June 27, 2023 to replace the class graduating on March 5, 2022.

 Angeles College, Los Angeles, Vocational Nursing Program – Requests Approved.

The Program requested the Board grant continued full approval for a four-year period beginning November 16, 2021 and issue a certificate accordingly.

Additionally, the Program requested approval to continue the programs established pattern of admissions.

• Glendale Career College, Vocational Nursing Program – Request Approved.

The Program requested the Board grant continued full approval for a four-year period beginning November 14, 2021 and issue a certificate accordingly.

 Quest Nursing Education Center, Vocational Nursing Program – Requests Approved.

The Program requested to admit a part-time day class of 30 students to commence on January 3, 2022 with a projected graduation date of March 31, 2023 to replace the class graduating on December 3, 2021.

Additionally, the Program requested to admit a part-time evening class of 30 students to commence on January 3, 2022 with a projected graduation date of March 31, 2023 to replace the class graduating on December 3, 2021.

• Unitek College, San Jose, Vocational Nursing Program - Requests Approved.

The Program requested the Board grant continued full approval for a four-year period beginning November 16, 2021 and issue a certificate accordingly.

Additionally, the Program requested the Board approve the part-time evening and weekend class of 36 students to start on November 22, 2021, with a graduation date of June 12, 2023. This is not a replacement class or to be added to the ongoing pattern admission at this time.

Additionally, the Program requested approval to continue the programs established pattern of admissions.

Effective November 30, 2021:

 American Career College, Ontario, Vocational Nursing Program – Request Approved.

The Program requested the Board grant continued full approval for a four-year period beginning December 1, 2021 and issue a certificate accordingly.

 Gurnick Academy of Medical Arts, Concord, Psychiatric Technician Program – Request Approved.

The Program requested to admit a full-time day class of 15 students commencing on January 3, 2022, graduating on December 16, 2022, to replace the class that graduates on December 17, 2021.

 High Desert Medical College, Bakersfield, Vocational Nursing Program – Request Approved.

The Program requested to admit a full-time class of 23 students to commence on January 10, 2022 with an expected graduation date of March 21, 2023.

• MiraCosta College, Vocational Nursing Program - Request Approved.

The Program requested the Board grant continued full approval for a four-year period beginning November 15, 2021 and issue a certificate accordingly.

Rio Hondo College, Vocational Nursing Program – Request Approved.

The Program requested the Board grant continued full approval for a four-year period beginning November 15, 2021 and issue a certificate accordingly.

Effective December 30, 2021:

 Gurnick Academy of Medical Arts, Sacramento, Vocational Nursing Program – Requests Approved.

The Program requested the Board grant initial approval for the four-year period beginning December 30, 2021 and issue a certificate accordingly.

Additionally, the Program requested to begin a vocational nursing program with an initial full-time class of 60 students on January 3, 2022, only, and graduating January 27, 2023. Thirty of these students will be in an AM class and thirty students will be in a PM class.

Additionally, the Program requested the Board approve the program's 52-week full-time curriculum, four terms of 1570 hours, including 616 theory hours and 954 clinical hours.
